#### STUDENT A

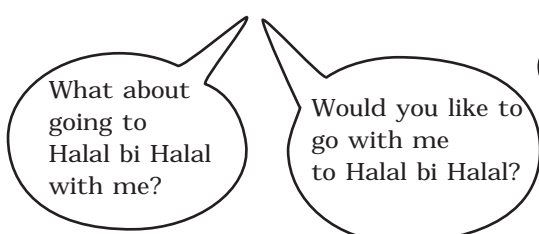
1. You invite your friend to go to the canteen. Student B can go with you.

#### STUDENT B

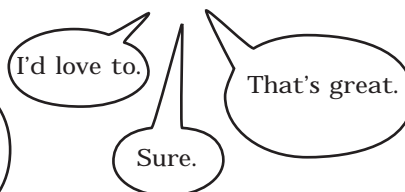
1. You invite your friend to go to the mall tomorrow. Student A can go with you.
