Aisyah: Let's go to the other side.

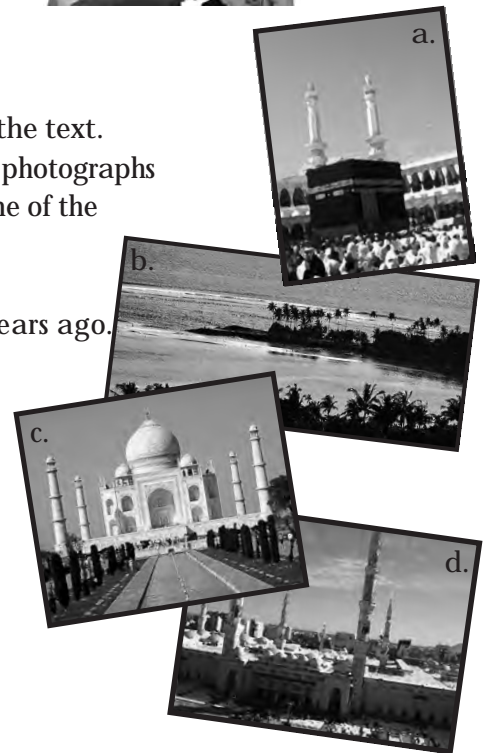
Abdul: Hey look! What a nice beach. Do you know where it is?

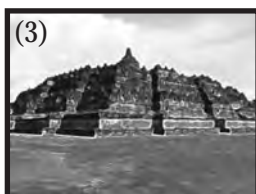
