



14 Muslim to Muslim

“All believers are brothers, establish peacefulness between your brothers and be afraid of Allah in order to receive mercy.” (Al- Hujuraat: 10)

A. Read the dialogue carefully.

 Lukman : He's got dengue fever, ma'am. He's in hospital.

 Lukman, can you please collect contributions from all students then give the money to Fauzan's parents?
 Lukman : Sure, ma'am. I'll do that after class.
 Wiwin : But..., excuse me, ma'am. Can we wait until he gets better and goes back to school?
 I'm worried we'll be infected.
 Teacher : Dengue fever is not infectious, Wiwin. We should visit him to give him support.
 Remember that Prophet Muhammad also said there are six obligations of Muslim to Muslim.
 What are they, everyone?
 Yanto : Umm..... When you meet, you should greet each other. If one is sick, the other should visit him/her.
 If you are invited, you should respond.
 Teacher : Very good, Yanto. What else?
 Fatma : I'll try, ma'am. If one sneezes and prays, you should say, "Allah bless you."
 If one asks for advice, you should advise him/her. And, if someone dies, you should pay your condolences.
 Teacher : Excellent, Fatma.
